WATER Atwood Lake

FISHING REPORT DATE: Concession is closed for the season - no report will be available until spring 2007.

FISHING REPORT DATE: 10-06-06

WATER CONDITIONS: 65 degrees

FISH: channel catfish ... good using stinkbaits and nightcrawlers off the banks in 3-6 feet deep water and averaging anywhere between 1-4 pounds in size.

FISH: bluegill ... good using wax worms off the banks in 1-4 feet deep water and averaging 5-8 inches.

WATER CONDITIONS: 68 degrees

FISH: channel catfish ... good using stinkbaits and nightcrawlers off the banks in 3-6 feet deep water and averaging anywhere between 1-4 pounds in size.

FISH: catfish ... good using stink baits and nightcrawlers off the banks in 4 to 8 feet deep water - sizes are averaging 1-4 pounds

FISH: bluegill ... good using red worms or wax worms off the banks in 3 feet deep water - sizes are averaging 6-8 inches.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using stinkbaits and fishing off the banks in 4-8 feet deep water - sizes are averaging anywhere between 1-4 pounds.

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using topwater baits and fishing off the banks at the weed edges - sizes are averaging 1-3 pounds.

FISH: bluegill ... excellent using wax worms off the banks in 1-4 feet deep of water and averaging 6-8 inches in size.

WATER CONDITIONS: There is no change in the fishing report for this week.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using stink baits off the banks in the sandy spots and sizes averaging anywhere between 1-4 pounds.

WATER CONDITIONS: 74 degrees

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using leeches off the banks in 3-5 feet deep water - sizes are anywhere between 12-16 inches in length.

FISH: bluegill ... good using wax worms off the banks in 1-2 feet deep water - sizes are averaging between 6-9 inches.

FISH: catfish ... good using stinkbaits off the banks in 5-10 feet deep water and averaging anywhere between 1-4 pounds.

WATER CONDITIONS: There is no fishing report available for this week.

WATER CONDITIONS: 63 degrees

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using leeches and nightcrawlers off the banks in 2-5 feet deep water - sizes are anywhere between 1-3 pounds and 12-18 inches in length.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using nightcrawlers and stink baits off the banks in 4-8 feet deep water - sizes are averaging anywhere between 1-5 pounds.

FISH: bluegill ... excellent using wax and red worms off the banks in 1-4 feet deep water and averaging 6-8 inches.

FISHING REPORT DATE: 05-19-06

WATER CONDITIONS: 58 degrees

FISH: largemouth bass ... fair using leeches and nightcrawlers off the banks in 1-3 feet deep water - sizes are anywhere between 1-3 pounds.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using nightcrawlers off the banks in 2-6 feet deep water - sizes are averaging anywhere between 1-5 pounds.

WATER CONDITIONS: 63 degrees and clear

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using leeches and nightcrawlers off the banks- sizes are averaging 1-4 pounds and 12-20 inches - bass are spawning close to the banks.

FISH: bluegill ... good using wax and red worms off the banks 1-4 feet deep water - sizes are averaging 6-8 inches.

FISHING REPORT DATE: 05-05-06

WATER CONDITIONS: 61 degrees and clear

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using leeches off the banks in the shallows - sizes are averaging 1-4 pounds.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using nightcrawlers and stink baits off the banks in 3-6 feet water - sizes are averaging 1-3 pounds.

WATER CONDITIONS: 60 degrees

FISH: rainbow trout ... good using wax worms off the banks and fishing on the bottoms - sizes are averaging 10-12 inches.

FISH: channel catfish ... good using nightcrawlers and stinkbaits off the banks on the bottoms with sizes ranging anywhere between 1-3 pounds.

FISH: largemouth bass ... good using leeches and nightcrawlers off the banks in 1-5 feet off the shore - sizes are averaging 12-16 inches.

FISHING REPORT DATE: 04-14-06

WATER CONDITIONS: water is clear and 49 degrees

FISH: rainbow trout ... good using wax worms and power baits off the banks and fishing on the bottoms - sizes are averaging 12-14 inches.

FISH: channel catfish ... fair using nightcrawlers off the banks on the bottoms with sizes ranging anywhere between 1 1/2 to 3 pounds.

WATER CONDITIONS: water is clear and 43 degrees

FISH: trout ... are excellent right now using wax worms and power baits on the windy side of the banks - sizes are ranging anywhere between 12-14 inches and 1-14 pounds.
